

# University Entrance: Winter and Spring 2011

---

To be eligible for winter entry programs, applicants must have completed the OSSD requirements by January, unless otherwise specified. Applicants may apply online to university programs that have winter entry availability.

Students will access the online application by using access codes provided by their guidance counsellors. Counsellors at secondary schools registered for SSOLA will generate these access codes by using the "Create a PIN" option available through Counsellors' Online Services (COLS).

This service will be available at the beginning of October, which provides ample time for applications to be completed before the deadline dates specified by the universities.

Once students have submitted their applications to the OUAC, guidance counsellors can either log in to the "Academic Updates" option of COLS to update the students' academic records, or they can submit official transcripts to the OUAC for input along with the OUAC Form for Current Registered Courses. This form is available online at <http://guidance.ouac.on.ca>, under "Forms". Please be sure to note the student's OUAC Reference Number on the form.

Counsellors at schools not registered for SSOLA should return the completed application forms to the OUAC prior to the deadline date specified by the university. To identify winter entry applicants, please print "January Entry" in large letters on the envelope.
